

You only will be saved through faith in Jesus Christ

- I. If you have such faith, know where that came from
- II. If you have such faith, recognize how it acts within you
- III. If you have such faith, rejoice in what it brings you (art 22-24)

I/II. If you have saving faith, know where it comes from and how it acts

- A. The stream always has a fountain: *so saving faith always has a source* Eph 2:8
 1. If you recognize the marks of saving faith, there is one reason: Eph. 2:10
- B. What is saving (justifying) faith? (from the Westminster Catechism)
 1. *Justifying faith is a saving grace, wrought (worked) in the heart of a sinner, by the Spirit and Word of God, whereby he, being convinced of his sin and misery, and of the disability in himself and all other creatures to recover him out of his lost condition, not only assents to the truth of the promise of the Gospel, but receives and rests upon Christ and His righteousness, therein held forth for pardon of sin, and for the accepting and accounting of his person righteous in the sight of God for salvation.*
 2. True faith can *assent* to Jesus while not always able to *embrace* Him
- C. What is implied or described by *embracing Jesus Christ and all His merits*?
 1. Implies the *conscious letting go of all other grounds*: Phil. 3:3-9
 2. Implies the embracing of the whole Christ: Phil. 3:10-12
 3. Implies the embracing of Christ for ‘better or worse’: Heb. 11:24-27
 4. Implies the embracing of Christ for Himself: Song 5:16
 5. Implies the embracing of Christ with all your desires: Ps. 27:8; Phil. 3:9
 6. Implies the embracing of Christ willingly: Song of Sol. 1:2-4
 7. Implies the embracing of Christ exclusively: Acts 4:12
 8. Includes an appropriating of Christ: Song of Sol 2:3; 7:10
