Intro: What is the good of it, the profit, the benefit, the advantage?

You only will be saved through your faith in Jesus Christ (5)

- I. If you have such faith, know where that came from
- II. If you have such faith, recognize how it acts within you
- III. If you have such faith, rejoice in what it brings you (art 22-24)

III. If you have a faith that unites you to Jesus, rejoice in what it brings you!

A. Saving faith unites a sinner with the Lord Jesus

B. But what is **now** (!) the profit if you have saving faith?

1. You are righteous before God in Christ: Rom. 3:23-24; 4:6-7; Col. 1:22

a. this is true *despite an experiential awareness of being unrighteous*

b. be careful not to misunderstand the Gospel declaration: Rom. 3:26; 4:5

c. all who embraces Jesus in faith (Ps. 31:1) are described in Ps. 32:1-2

C. What other benefits are yours as a justified sinner in Jesus Christ?

1. You will grow in the adoration of God: Ps. 115:1; Rev. 7:9-10

2. You will grow in genuine humility: 1 Tim. 1:12-15


3. You will be a child of the Father and all His is yours: 1 Cor. 3:21-23

4. You will have confidence to come to your Father: Rom. 5:1-2; Eph. 3:12

(5. You will be enabled to live a new life through and for Him: Eph. 2:10)
