A. They are *illustrations of the future* of God's people (*eschatological*)

B. They are *illustrate the salvation* of God's people (*soteriological*)

C. The *salvation* teachings in the healing of Mrs. Unclean

1. She could not be helped by humanity's best methods (25-26)

2. She heard about Jesus (27-28)

3. She acted her faith in Him: (27b)

4. She experienced Jesus' power as she touched Him in faith (29-30)

5. She feared and trembled even though she experienced His power (33)

I. Jesus declares that your faith in Him had saved you

II. Jesus directs you to go into the peace He earned for you

III. Jesus promises you to complete His salvation in you

Dear children,
