Jesus calls you to abide in Him (2)

I. What is abiding? II. How do you abide in Jesus?

III. What is fruit of abiding in Jesus?

Review:

A. Jesus called you as His disciples to abide in Him to experience (much) fruit

1. To abide is *to be connected* – have a *personal relationship* with Him

2. This abiding in Him needs to remain our spiritual focus

3. Our abiding in Him is by 'His word abiding in us' (vs. 7)

B. Jesus revealed in vs. 9 a staggering truth that ought to 'abide in us'

1. Ponder the *comparison* of 'As ... so'

a. Savour the nature of Father's love to His Son (Prov. 8:30; Is. 41:1-8)

b. Savour Jesus' extension of the Father's love in John 16:27

c. Savour Jesus' un-bosoming of His heart of love in vs. 9b:

2. Heed the Lord's exhortation to *continue in my love* (vs. 9c)

Eat, O friends; drink, yea, drink abundantly, O beloved. (Song 5:1)
