I. What you were II. What you became III. What you are now IV. What you will be.

I. What you were!

A. This truth applies to all who hear the Word!

- 1. You all were crowned: Ps. 8:5-8
- 2. You were declared very good (Gen. 1:31, 27)
- 3. You were in a personal covenant with God (Gen. 2:7; 15-16)

II. What you became!

- A. You degraded yourself to the level of a beast: Ps. 49:20
- B. You became an indescribable wreck: Eph. 2:1-3; Rom 3:10ff; 5:610; 8:7
 - 1. It was no accident but a choice that you became like that: Gen. 3:1-6
 - 2. It was a willing choice when you degraded yourself (see sum in CoF 14)
- C. Your condition is now desperate: you can do nothing else but sin!
 - 1. But what about the good you still do?

III. What are you now?

- A. If you are like the Ephesians, you are changed and changing (Eph. 2:1-10)
 - 1. Examine if you are changed from being dead to alive?
 - 2. If changed, how did this happen: Titus 3:3-7

IV. What you will be!

A. You will be glory with God (vs. 7)

B. You will be beyond Adam in Paradise: Ps. 89:15-18
