I. God teaches us that we are all guilty people

- A. Romans 5:12-21: our guilt-issue
 - 1. We learn that both Adam and Christ are representatives of groups
 - 2. We learn how each affected their group
 - a. vs. 12: sin vs. salvation
 - b. vs. 15, 17: death vs. life
 - c. vs. 16, 18: condemnation vs. justification
 - d. vs. 19: sinners vs. righteous
 - e. vs. 20, 21: reign of death reign of eternal life
 - 3. We learn that Adam's deed of sin applies personally to you
 - a. We are guilty in Adam (Rom. 5:12)
 - b. This is proved in fact of Romans 5:13-14
- B. The result: we are born as 'children of wrath' (Eph. 2:3)

(II. God's Word and experience teach us we all are also sinful people)

- B. Yet it is wasted energy to resist our sovereign God's arrangement!
- C. Thankfully God did not leave us stranded in Adam's fall!
