I. We are guilty of treason (Rom. 5:12)

II. We are utterly corrupt

- A. Besides inherited guilt, we have inherited corruption (original sin)
 - 1. God's own perspective: Gen. 6:5, 11; Mark 7:20-23 (Rom. 3:12)
 - 2. David's perspective: Ps. 51:1-6 (Ps. 58:3; Titus 3:3, Eph. 2:3)
- B. The summary: Jeremiah 17:9 & Romans 7:18 vs. 1 Peter 1:13-16
 - 1. God searches our *heart* (Ps. 7:9)
 - 2. God calls blessed hearts that hunger and thirst for holiness (Matt. 5:4)
 - 3. God identifies the sins of the flesh: Gal. 5:19-21
- C. Confessional summaries: CoF art. 15; Canons of Dort III/IV, art. 2-4; Cat. 113

From here ...

- A. Each sinful bubbling of your corrupt heart is sin, even if you don't act on it!
- B. Desires of the flesh towards the same sex, does not make you a worse sinner!
- C. No condition of our fallen nature is beyond Christ's redemption: 1 Cor. 6:9-11
