God is trustworthy because He has kept and will keep His promise to you

- I. As promised, God did send forth His Son as the Warrior against Satan
- A. 'In the fulness of time' (Gal. 4:4)
 - 1. After 4000 years of failure and continued rebellion (Acts 14:16-17)
 - 2. God sent forth His Son (John 3:16-17)
 - 3. He let Him be born as the seed of the woman (Gen. 3:15)
 - a. He came as the Warrior to battle against the Satan and sinners
 - consider 1 John 3:8b; John 12:31; 14:31
 - b. Finally He inflicted His crushing victory over Satan: John 19:30
- II. As promised, God send His Son as the Redeemer of sinners
- A. God 'made Him under the law' (See CoF art, 20): why?
 - 1. Because your problem is not just Satan
 - 2. Because your greatest problem is yourself: you are the sinner!
- B. God's Gospel: He sent His Son made under law to redeem them under law
 - 1. Jesus took the place of sinners He became the Mediator by substitution
 - 2. Heart of the Gospel: the atonement through substitution (2 Cor. 5:21)
 - 3. Why did God do this for us?
