You only will be saved through your faith in Jesus Christ

- I. If you have such faith, know where that came from
- II. If you have such faith, recognize how it acts within you
- III. If you have such faith, rejoice in what it brings you (art 22-24)

I. If you have saving faith, know where it comes from

- A. All natural & spiritual life comes from God: Gen. 2:7; Acts 17:25b; Eph. 2:-18
- B. Why is it so important to understand and believe this *revelation*?
 1. so you will be *confident* like Paul (Phil 1:6)
 2. so you be careful *not to despise God's gracious work* within you (John 6:44)

II. If you have faith in Jesus Christ, recognize how it acts within you


- A. Saving faith is *supernatural – mystical – mysterious* (Canons ¾, 14)
 1. Any exercise of faith you do is *a result of God's working within you*
 2. Don't get sidetracked by *when/how* but focus on *what is saving faith*
- B. What are the acts of upright faith?
 1. Saving faith always *has the same object* in all: *Christ Jesus Alone*
 - a. HS has one chief purpose and delight: John 16:13
 - b. He may need a bit of work to get you to surrender to Jesus
 - c. HS ways to lead you to Jesus may differ but His destination is one
 2. Saving faith is known by your *soul or hearts exercises* with Jesus Christ
 - a. those soul exercises are *not always the same* (immature/mature)
 - b. observe Jesus's various descriptions of saving faith in John 6
- C. Be clear: *your faith* is not saving unless ... !
 1. Meditate upon picture of Leviticus 4:30
 2. Observe the similarity with Jesus repeated message in John 3:15; 6:35; 52

Reflect: Seeking peace and joy in believing?

- A. Avoid Thomas stubbornness (John 20:24-29)
- B. Consider Abraham' faith: Romans 4:20; Heb. 11:6)
- C. Make Romans 15:13 your prayer point!
