Jesus message of certainty: My death defeated Satan's ruling power

I. Jesus' words is to remind you that His main mission was to defeat Satan

A. This is beginning the good news

1. without His mission we would be forever out of commission: John 8:23, 44
2. when we took Satan's bait, we became Satan's mate: Gen. 3:9-13
3. God's first glorifying light is when He declared to fight: Gen. 3:15

B. Yet Satan would not go without a fight

1. The OT is the history of *Satan's fight to prevent Jesus from being born*
2. The NT Gospels is the history of *Satan's fight to trip up Jesus*

C. Then Jesus announced: *The hour is come* (vs. 23)

1. Jesus' own soul trouble about his hour is fierce: v 27; *Luke 23:53*

D. Reflect: Do you recognize Jesus' battle against Satan and sin in yourself?

II. Jesus' words are to assure you that He has defeated Satan's rule forever

A. This is more of the good news in vs. 31

1. Reflect on Satan's power-grip
 - a. As prince of darkness he controlled all kingdoms' world (Mat 4:8)
2. Yet Jesus says that *the hour is NOW that Satan is dethroned*: 31b
 - a. define 'judgment'
 - b. the cross is Jesus' Armageddon (Rev. 16:16)
 - c. when Jesus' 'hour' was finished, Satan's head(ship) was finished
3. You are invited to drink deeply from this cup of comfort: Is. 40:1

B. How did our Lord Jesus dethrone Satan as prince of the world?

1. He did this by *being obedient to His Father's will*
2. See the contrast between the *first Adam* and the *last Adam*
3. This last act of obedience earned Jesus the right to be King: Phil. 2:8-10

Reflect:

1. Let this truth comfort you who are His people (John 12:26)
2. Let this truth convict you who are not serving Him (John 12:25)
3. Let that draw you who still live still stand apart from Him (John 12:32; 35-36)
