SCRIPTURE: Romans 8 with Lord's Day 1.1

SINGING: 86:1-3-71:1-5-174:1-4-422:5-6

Intro: Jesus called men to fish for men (Mark 1:17) with the best bait (Rom. 8)

- A. Lord's Day 1.1 is the most brilliant echo of Romans 8
 - 1. Packed between the covers of *No condemnation* (vs. 1) and *No separation* (vs. 39) are pages of *Divine Comforts*
 - 2. The "confession of faith" in Lord's Day 1.1
 - a. is forged in the fires of trials (2 Tim. 1:11-12; 4:6-8)
 - b. is learned as gold is dug out and sifted out (Prov. 2:3-5)
- B. Why do we keep teaching Scripture through the Heidelberg Catechism?
 - 1. Because it is a most excellent summary of 'gems of Holy Scripture'
 - 2. Because it is not just doctrine but **devotional doctrine**

The Unbelievers' Discomfort versus the Believers' Comfort

I. The Unbeliever's Discomfort: To be insecure outside of Jesus Christ

- A. The cause of all our discomforts is our separation from God
 - 1. God did not hide the truth about sin
 - a. Rom 5:12 Wherefore, as by one man sin entered into the world, and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned.
 - 2. We now all live outside Paradise under the curse
 - a. Eph. 2:3 ... and where by nature children of wrath, even as others
 - 3. We face the ultimate summon to appear before our Judge
 - a. 2 Cor. 5:10: For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ; that everyone may receive the things done in his body, according to that he hath done, whether it be good or bad
- B. This is the depressing truth and unsettling truth (the *Bad News*)
 - 1. Every human effort to remedy has failed
 - a. Eccl. 7:29 Lo, this only have I found, that God hath made man upright; but they have sought out many inventions

II. The believers' Comfort: To be secure in Jesus Christ

- A. Not every believer possesses this level of assurance of faith
 - 1. Goal of Catechism:
 - a. Romans 15:13 Now the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, that ye may abound in hope, through the power of the Holy Ghost
- B. The witness of Lordøs Day 1.1 is alluring and personal
 - 1. This is not a *doctrinal statement biography of a saints experience*
 - 2. It is a testimony about glory of Jesus in life of a sinner
- C. What is the only Comfort in life and death: it is to belong to Jesus Christ!
 - 1. Meaning of to belong to Jesus Christ
 - a. He purchased me with the ransom price of His blood (Rom 8:3)
 - b. He delivered and keeps me from the power of the devil (Rom. 8:7-9)
 - c. He guards me as the apple of His eye (Rom. 8:28-29)
 - d. He assures me that \pm all is well that will end wellø(Rom. 8:30; 18-25)
 - e. He promises to be my enabler in all weaknesses (Rom. 8:14-15, 26)
 - f. He assures me of my future portion (Rom. 8:9)

Closing: Are you hooked to find this precious treasure for yourself?

Thoughts to consider

- 1. Discuss the following statement: *There are many paths that lead to Christ as there are feet to tread them. But there is only one way to God.*
- 2. Illustrate the truth Pink wrote, No sinner was ever saved by giving his heart to God. We are not saved by our giving but by God's giving.
- 3. Often we use words without fully grasping the meaning. Define from Scripture the word -salvation.ø
