II. One sinner's dealing with Jesus was to confess Him

A. The Gospel leads to *hardening* or *melting* of the hearts: Matt. 11:25-26

B. Mr. Wise became truly wise: *what does wisdom look like?*

1. Wisdom is when you see yourself as vs. 40: *condemned*

a. our condemnation is not future: Gal. 3:10; John 3:18, 36b

b. this is a fact independent of whether you 'feel it as true'

2. Wisdom is when you fear God: vs. 40

a. to fear God the is beginning of true joy: Prov. 14:27

b. to not fear God is the most foolish foolishness: Luke 12:4-5

3. Wisdom is when you embrace God's dealings as just: vs. 41a

B. Greatest wisdom is that *when you confess Jesus as only Name*: vs. 41b-42

1. Hear his amazing confession about a naked crucified man (1 Cor. 12:3)

2. Hear his humble plea in his prayer: Remember me ... !

**Reflection of the Gospel Revelation:**

A. Jesus is still the same today: *today yet able to save to the uttermost!*

B. Jesus' declaration to all penitent believers is same today: *John 5:24*
