I. How was He forsaken? II. Why was He forsaken? III. Why is He forsaken our hope?

I. How was He forsaken?

- A. He was forsaken in a way we will never understand
 - 1. How can Son of God be forsaken of God?
 - 2. Yet the God-man Jesus experienced this is a real and fearful: Ps. 22:1-2
- B. Jesus lost all connection with His Father in His deepest darkness: Ps. 22:12-13

II. Why is He forsaken?

- A. The Father has chosen His Son Jesus to be forsaken for sinners (1 Peter 3:18)
 - 1. On the cross Jesus experienced the worst rejection: Gal. 3:13
 - 2. To understand 'why', we first need to step back into the Genesis 3 story
 - a. Place yourself in Genesis 3!
 - b. time to confess
 - 3. To understand 'why' more, we need to think about 'God's two hands'
 - a. hand of justice: Give Me payment
 - b. hand of grace: Forgive them their sins
 - 4. God's wisdom provided the solution: a holy Jesus forsaken!

III. Why is His being forsaken our hope?

A. In this 'forsaken Jesus' God opens door of hope for you

B. If you take your refuge & rest on this forsaken Jesus, then ponder sweetly the Father's answer on Jesus' piercing cry on Easter morning
