As believers in Christ, you are eternally secure!

## I. Sadly, this is not true if you still live separate from Jesus Christ

- A. Are you still filled with doubts about Jesus (vs. 24-26)?
- B. How does Jesus answer your doubts?
  - 1. He reminds you of what He told you already: vs. 25a
  - 2. He appeals to you about the witness of His works: vs. 25b
  - 3. He rebukes you for not believing Him: vs. 26

## II. Yet as believers you may still be filled with doubts about now & future

- A. Do you recognize yourself in the doubts and fears like the unbelieving Jews?
- B. Learn from Jesus' method to answer your doubts (25-27)
  - 1. Let His witnessing works within you silence your doubts (John 9:25)
- C. Yet Jesus also wants you to believe what He declares and promises: 27b
  - 1. **He declares**: I know my sheep
  - 2. **He promises**: I give unto them eternal life

## III. But then Jesus adds the assurance: you are in the safest hands!

- A. Though you are in a dangerous territory as helpless as sheep, you are safe!
- B. Your security as Jesus' sheep is not in you: in Him and in His Father!
  - 1. You shall never perish because you are in Jesus hands! (Is. 49:14-16)
  - 2. In addition to His, you are in the Father's hands!
- C. Therefore, Jesus wants you to face the future with confidence, rest, and joy!
