Refresh:

- A. Being a Christian you are kept (John 10:28-29) but not from war (Eph 6:12)!
- B. Though God protects you, God expects you to fight fiercely (Eph. 6:10-13)

You will win the battle when you rely on Me!

I. The secret of your success is in relying on the Lord when you fight!

- A. Jesus' word "finally' (vs. 10) is not the 'conclusion' but the 'secret'
 - 1. You need to 'fight' reflecting on '3 X what...'
- B. You only can successfully use God's armor if you rely on Him (vs. 10)
 - 1. Be strong (1 Sam. 30:6)
 - 2. Yet be strong in the Lord and in the power of His (God's) might
- C. So what kind of soldier are you as a Christian among the 4 kinds?

II. So if you seek to be a strong in the Lord warrior, what will you do about it?

- A. Avoid everything that weakens you (Lloyd Jones)
- B. Avoid taking off your eyes from your Captain (John 15:4-5)
- C. Avoid forgetting to **put on** the whole armor of God and use it (11, 13)

Reflect:

- A. How do you want to be at end of battle? (2 Tim. 4:6-8)
- B. The Lord is still enlisting new warriors. (Proverbs 23:26)
