

ELIJAH'S LAST MISSION 2 KINGS 1(CONTINUED.)

13 and 14. A third captain with his fifty came to meet up with Elijah.

He uses the same words: " O man of God" acknowledging Elijah indeed was God's servant.

He earnestly prayed Elijah to save not only his life but also "the life of these THY servants..."

What an humbleness...What had happened with this captain?

In Luke 9:51-54 we read the "Elijah and the fire story" of the N.T.—apparently in the same place Samaria.

Why is the outcome different in this story?

15. Again the command: "Go down with him" And he arose on the command of the Lord.

16. Elijah stood before the king Ahaziah, spoke the same words to him as Elijah did to his servants.

What was the same in Elijah's message from beginning to the end?

Did Ahaziah's servants actually go to inquire at Baalzebub?

17 and 18. In Genesis 5 we read repeatedly:" And he died...and he died." A solemn truth for all of us!

Is there a difference in "And he died" and "So he died?"
