THE ASCENSION OF CHRIST

1. The circumstances surrounding Christ's ascension

- After resurrection Jesus taught His disciples many things (Lk. 24:27):
 - The work He *had* done.
 - To prepare them for what He *was going to do*.
- The disciples still have wrong thinking.
- Faith is entrusting yourself to God.

2. The reality of Christ's ascension

- Ascension of Christ:
 - Fulfilling Scripture (Ps 68);
 - A miracle;
 - Witnessed by men;
 - Explained by angels;
 - \circ To the throne room of God.

3. The meaning of Christ's ascension;

- Ascension is to His glory.
 - The angels welcome Him;
 - The Father welcomes Him (Acts 1:2,9; cf. Heb. 1:8-9).
- The labour He is doing in Heaven is to benefit His Church (Jn. 16:7; HC18:46,49; Eph. 4:8-12).
 - As High Priest (Heb. 4:14);
 - As King (Ps 45:4);
 - As Prophet (Deut. 18:18; Jn. 17:6-8).

4. The return following Christ's ascension

- He returns in glory and every knee shall bow before Him (Mat. 13:40-43, 49-50; Mat. 24:30-31; Gen. 41:43; Isa. 45:23).
- How shall we stand there?
- Consider the fruit of Chris's ascension is to live by faith:
 - Heaven is opened.
 - Jesus is the Way to the Father
 - Joy in the heart (Lk 24:52b).
