

Scripture: Romans 7:14 – Romans 8:8
Singing: 317:1-2 – 294:1-3 – 147:1, 3, 4 – 172:1-4

Intro: Hannah's song contains a remarkable line of truth (1 Sam. 2:6-7)
The LORD killeth, and maketh alive; He bringeth down to the grave, and bringeth up. The LORD maketh poor and maketh rich: he bringeth low, and lifteth up.

- A. Pray as you listen: *That which I see not teach Thou me!* (Job 34:32)
1. Our first two visit with the Soul Physician brought to light *unsettling truth*
 - a. we do not love God as Jesus, the Son of man, does (Luke 22:42, 44)

 - b. we do not love neighbors as Son of man does (Matt 5:43-48)

 - c. this confirms that 'all are gone out of the way' (Rom. 3:12; Gen. 6:5)
 2. Sadly: *there is more unsettling news in God's report*
 - a. consider Romans 8:7-8; Jer. 2:22, 25; Jer. 13:23; Matt. 7:18; 1 Cor 2:14

THE DESPERATE CASE OF OUR CARNAL MIND

I. It is death II. It is enmity

I. The Carnal Mind is death

- A. Our 'carnal mind' (vs. 7) is as root to the fruit (minding of flesh vs. 5-6)
1. The carnal mind and minding of things of the flesh (sin) is *spiritual condition*

 2. This condition does not *lead* to death but *is death* (Rom. 8:6)
 - a. It is true that *our sinful deeds/choices leads to death* (Rom. 2:4-11)

 - b. It is also true that *our sinfulness (condition) is present death*
 - definition of death

 - evidence of death

 - c. If *now* to be like that is 'death' already, what will be the future be?

 3. This is the spiritual condition of every *unrenewed heart*

II. The Carnal Mind is enmity against God

- A. This is by far the hardest hitting truth about natural man
1. We are *enemies* of God while being religious: Titus 3:3, Mark 10:22
 - a. Are you a *mercenary Christian*?

 2. Yet we are more than enemies: ***we are enmity against God***
 - a. a 'carnal mind' that is an enemy, is not quite so bad

 - b. but a carnal mind that is enmity, is a crushing message
 - a *sinner* can convert but *sinfulness* cannot convert

 - c. why Q/A. 5 & 8 of Heidelberg Catechism is spot-on

- A. Do you understand Jews in John 6:60 *This is a hard saying: who can hear it?*
- B. Do you grasp HOW bitter – crushing but also how appalling this truth is?
- C. Why be angry with Him *telling* us this 'black/white' truth?
