- His song a response to a question.

The Work of the Lord.

- He has visited and redeemed His people.
- Israel and the church have not deserved God's compassion.
- How we should long for His coming and His visiting and blessing our personal lives.
- We need to be redeemed.
- He has redeemed His people! He has accomplished His work!
- Christ has also required the application of salvation.
- He has raised up a Horn of Salvation for us in the house of David.
