I. Jesus' love for those that love Him

A. Jesus is 'wisdom' speaker in this whole chapter of Proverbs 8

1. He is the most awesome Being: *from eternity – almighty – rich (12-31)*

2. He is interested in you

Unto you, O men, I call; and my voice is to the sons of man (vs. 4)

B. Jesus tells that He *loves: I love ... !*

1. When Jesus says that *He loves ...* what does He mean?

a. *He is committed to help & care always!*

b. *He is committed to comfort*

c. *He is committed to forgive*

d. *He is committed to stick it out in faithfulness*

d. *He is committed to shepherd the sheep all their life till Home!*

e. *He is committed to minister Himself*

2. Is there anyone Who loves like Jesus loves?

3. To be loved by Jesus is most special love you will ever experience!

C. Jesus tells that He *loves those that love Him*

1. Do you wonder whether *Jesus loves you?*

a. God's answer: *we love Him because He first loved us (1 John 4:19)*

b. so if you love God, it means that God put His love in you first!

D. What do children that love Him look like?

1. If you love Jesus, your *heart* will be more and more committed to Jesus

2. To know if you love Jesus, you are to examine your own heart

a. check your *desires*

b. check your *tears*

c. check your *choices*

d. check your *company*

e. check your *trust*
