Scripture: 1 Peter 1:13-25 Lord's Day 44

**Singing:** 292:1, 3, 4-309:1-4-420:2, 3-336:1-2

Intro: The 10<sup>th</sup> is not just the 'last' commandment!

- A. What did God make known in the teachings about His law?
  - 1. That God's law is the reflection of God's beauty: Ps. 90:17; 96:9
  - 2. That God's law is the expression of His great love: Rom. 10:5; 13:8, 10
  - 3. That exposition of God's law is seen fullest in Jesus: Matt. 5:20
  - 4. That God's purpose in teaching the law is reformation and transformation
- D. How does God accomplish this spiritual reformation & transformation?
  - 1. He does it *slowly or gradually* (see Cat. Q. 114)
  - 2. He does it *personally*: Eph. 2:10; Phil. 2:13; John 15:1-4
  - 3. He does it *mediately* (through the use of means)
    - a. Means of preaching the *highest standard of God* (q. 115)
    - b. Means of challenging people or circumstances: Acts 14:22
  - 4. He completes is immediately: 1 Cor. 15:51-57

The 10th Commandment: Honor me by being holy as I am holy!

- A. The 10<sup>th</sup> is not really a *separate commandment* (see Cat. 113)
  - 1. The 10th God's adverb to all other commandments!

- C. The saints' calling goes much farther than the 'do-not-do-part: 1 Peter 1:14-16

  The 'do-not-do part' are former lusts we lived in while ignorance (vs. 14)

  2. God's call goes much deeper: be holy in all manner of conversation (vs. 22)

  Jesus: Be ye therefore perfect, even as your Father which is in heaven is perfect (Matt. 5:48)
  - 3. What does 'be ye holy, perfect as I am' *practically* mean for us? a. It does NOT only mean *have any evil thoughts rise up* 
    - b. It means let only good thoughts rise up within you
    - c. What does that mean practically?

B. What does the 10<sup>th</sup> cover in practical daily living?

Close: Who is sufficient for living God's holy and good and just law?

- A. If God's law has *pricked humbled smashed* our self-image, bless God!
  - 1. We tend to maximize God's love at the expense of minimizing God's anger
  - 2. Rest not with *humbling convictions:* they are not saving!
- B. If God has increased your sense of defilement, fear not, fellow saints of God! 1. Meditate upon Hosea 11:7-9
  - T. Goodwin: There is comfort concerning such infirmities, in that your very sins move Him to pity more than to anger, as the heart of a father is drawn to his child with a loathsome disease.
