Intro: All saints share a likeness though all have different stories of salvation A. The three essentials of a true conversion are *universal* 

- B. Our task is to examine whether we know these essentials: 2 Cor. 13:5
  - 1. You cannot make or fake a change of heart
  - 2. Only you (besides God) can examine your heart
- C. Our task of examination is vital for spiritual health
  - 1. Needs to be done when we personally covenant with God (Matt. 10:37-39)
  - 2. Needs to be done after having made our confession of faith (2 Cor. 13:5)
  - 3. Needs to be done before partaking of the Lord's Table (1 Cor. 10-11)
  - 4. Needs to be done in reflection (1 Cor. 6:10; 2 Cor. 7:1)
- D. The 'standard' of our examination are God's saints in Scripture
  - 1. Mary Magdalene is woman delivered from bondage (Luke 8:2)
  - 2. She grew in her understanding of Jesus Christ (Mark 16:9; John 20:11-18)
  - 3. She became one of Jesus most faithful and humble followers (Luke 8:1-3)

## The Portrait of the Saint of God

I. Freed from bondage II. Looking unto Jesus III. Serving in love

## I. God's saints are freed from the bondage of sin

- A. When unsaved, you are in bondage like Mary Magdalene was (John 8:31-44)
  - 1. if unsaved you are *ruled by the power of darkness and live as an idolater* a. Eph. 2:1-3; 4:17-19
  - 2. yet while living in this bondage, you might feel as Saul in Rom. 7:9
- B. If saved, Jesus has entered into your heart & life as Deliverer (Luke 8:2)
  - 1. as He delivered Mary Magdalene, so he does with us: *breaks power of sin* a. by the opening of your 'mind' to sin (John 8:44)
    - b. by the agreement of your mind to God's judgment (Ps. 51)

## II. God's saints are looking to Jesus Christ as their only hope

- A. Only after Jesus delivered Mary Magdalene, she began to know Jesus Christ
  - 1. knowing everything about Him is no sign of being saved
  - 2. saving faith is *knowledge devotion surrender* (Luke 8:1; John 20:11-15)
- B. The main work of the Father is to unite us by faith to Jesus Christ
  - 1. He opens our mind (revelation) to Jesus as only hope, only Name: Acts 4:12
- C. This 'drawing of your heart' to Jesus is something you can observe and know!
  - 1. Mary Magdalene (john 20:15-16) Peter (John 21:15-17) knew it

## III. God's saints main joy is to serve King Jesus and His Kingdom

- A. Mary Magdalene gave her all to serve her Savior: Luke 8:1-3
- B. A true conversion is discipleship, no matter the cost (Luke 14:26-27)
  - 1. If you truly love Jesus, you want to serve Him in His Kingdom
  - 2. Active discipleship is the *outward* evidence of being a true Christian!
- C. You can examine whether you have truly enlisted yourself in Jesus' Kingdom!

Ye cannot drink the cup of the Lord, and the cup of devils:
Ye cannot be partaker of the Lord's table, and of the table of the devils.
